The unnatural combinations are wrong for native speakers of English. As an example, the adjective "fast" collocates with "cars" but not with "look." Learning collocations is the most important part of learning the vocabulary of a language. Some collocations seem fixed or very strong. In "take a photo," no word other than "take" collocates with the photo to give the same meaning. The other example is "make an effort" and not "do an effort." Some collocations are more open, because several words may go together to give a similar meaning, for example, "keep to or stick to the rules." Sometimes, a pair of words may not be wrong, and people will understand it, but it may not be the natural collocation.
